SUMMARY OF ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS OF CITING/REFEREE'S REPORT/DVD FOOTAGE

Referee's Report on Temporary Suspension & Sending-off

- 1. The YELLOW card was shown to Daystar Player No.7 Clinton Amukwachi in the second half of the match.
- 2. Daystar Player No.7 bit an unidentified Western Bulls player on the shoulder that had successfully tackled No.7 Daystar and brought him to ground. The incident happened as the tackler was rolling away.
- 3. The Match Referee quoted "9.27: A player must not do anything that is against the spirit of good sportsmanship including but not limited to":

- 4. Daystar Player No.7 punched an unidentified Western Bulls player on the chest following a ruck.
- 5. A second YELLOW card was shown to Daystar Player No.7 and upgraded to a RED card.

- Match Sheet, attached, confirms Team B (Daystar Player No7), Clinton Amukwachi received TWO YELLOW CARDS at 13:14hr and 13:37hr respectively during the second-half of a Championship match between Western Bulls and Daystar Falcons. The second Card resulted in a RED CARD Ordering-off.
- 2. The Match kicked-off at 12:00hr.

1. No medical report was presented - the Referees report is silent on any action relating to treatment or condition of the victim.

SUMMARY OF PLAYER'S EVIDENCE

The player:

- 1. Admitted the charge immediately
- 2. Expressed remorse

- 1. Was sorry for what had happened.
- 2. Apologised on behalf of Daystar Falcons
- 3. Endeavoured to ensure that the player understood the gravity of his actions and would not repeat such conduct in the future.

Daystar University Representative – John Yidah – Sports & Recreation Assistant, Daystar:

- 1. Was sorry for what had happened.
- 2. Apologised on behalf of Daystar University
- 3. Assured JO that the University took such matters seriously
- 4. Had talked to the player and warned him about the repercussions in the event of such conduct in the future.
- 5. Explained that the player risked losing his scholarship with Daystar and asked for leniency.

FINDINGS OF FACT

KRRS Representative - Alfred Okwemba

JO's Comments

- 1. YELLOW CARD No.1 was serious foul play, biting an opponent, and warranted a RED CARD. However, it was only brought to attention of the JO to enable him to assess the full picture as a second YELLOW CARD was issued to the same player resulting in a RED CARD ordering off of the Player. In the absence of citation of the player, the JO decided he would disregard the potential punishment for the player's act of foul play but take into account that he had received a YELLOW CARD in the same match.
- 2. The presence of a University official and his comments regarding the risk of the player losing his scholarship were taken into account it resulted in an extra 1 week deduction from his sanction as mitigation.
- 3. Match Sheet:
 - a. Times and incident for all key moments. I commend the quality of information on the Match Sheet.
 - b. AR1 & AR2 not named
- 4. Referee's Report:
 - a. Players aggrieved were not identified in both YELLOW CARD incidents.
 - b. It was not indicated whether the two incidents affected the match in any way, for example was the player treated, did he resume play? The omissions should be addressed by KRRA.

JO's Decision

The Judicial Officer categorised the RED CARD (as defined in the KRU Rugby XVs Competition Manual – Appendix Rules 20/21/22) as **mid-range** on the scale of seriousness and having considered aggravating and mitigating circumstances imposed upon the player a **six (6) week/match suspension**.

In accordance with the R.17.19.10 and in line with the player's schedule, he will serve suspension from 09 March 2024.

No award was made as to costs.

- In advance of the hearing, the Player/official and/or his advisors/Club should review the incident on the Union's/Host clubs copy of the DVD (per the time marker indicated on the report) if available. The Player/official should also review the regulations of the world rugby.
- The Player/official should be prepared with any arguments he may wish to present, including for the purposes of sanctioning, with respect to off-field mitigating factors (on-field mitigating factors are considered in setting the entry point in regulations) and/or the absence of any aggravating factors.
- The official should bring with him a copy of his disciplinary record in all rugby (Fifteens and Sevens at all levels, including, for the avoidance of doubt, international, junior and Club) and other sports if relevant. If a copy is not available, the Player shall inform the Judicial Officer orally of his disciplinary record when requested. The Player should be careful not to make any inaccurate or misleading statements in this regard.
