Referee's Report on Ordering-off

- 1. The RED card was shown Kenya Harlequins Player No.11 Zeden Marrow in the 27th minute of the match.
- 2. Kenya Harlequins Player No.11 tackled unidentified Nondescripts player no.6 Brian Amaitsa above the line of the shoulders.

 Team A (Kenya Harlequins) Player No.11 Zeden Marrow received a RED CARD in the 27th minute of a Kenya Cup match between Kenya Harlequins and Nondescripts.

ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS OF OTHER EVIDENCE (e.g. medical reports)

Medical

1. No medical report was presented – the Referees report is silent on any action relating to treatment or condition of the victim.

SUMMARY OF PLAYER'S EVIDENCE

The player:

Stated that:

- 1. He apologised for the incident
- 2. He had no intention of hitting the opponent on the head
- 3. The ball-carrier slipped as he was moving forward at speed, resulting in a very low body position at the point of impact.

Player Representative – Wayne Mung'ei – Asst. Team Manager, Kenya Harlequins:

1. The tackle was accidental and apologised for the incident.



FINDINGS OF FACT

KRRS Representative - Alfred Okwemba

Following review of video footage, he stated that:

- 1. As Player No.11, Zeden Marrow of Kenya Harlequins committed himself to tackle Player No.6 of Nondescripts, the latter was accelerating forward and slipped, resulting in a tackle above the line of the shoulders.
- 2. In his opinion, the tackle above the line of the shoulders could not have been avoided, and therefore, while a foul was committed, the RED CARD threshold was not met.

Match Officials

JO's Comments

 - a. All necessary information and key moments and timing, including substitutions have been captured. Highly commended!
- 2. Referee's Report:
 - a. Players' teams were identified by their shirt colours this should be avoided and the teams named .
 - b. The Referees Report did not indicate whether the incident affected the match in any way, for example was the player treated, did he resume play?

JO's Decision

The Judicial Officer, with the benefit of reviewing video footage availed, adjudged that **there was Foul Play but it did not merit a RED CARD** (as defined in the KRU Rugby XVs Competition Manual – Appendix Rules 20/21/22). The RED CARD was rescinded and **the player is free to play immediately.**

No award was made as to costs.

- During the hearing, the Judicial Officer will review the evidence and receive the official's submissions and evidence, including hearing from any witnesses.
- In advance of the hearing, the Player/official and/or his advisors/Club should review the incident on the Union's/Host clubs copy of the DVD (per the time marker indicated on the report) if available. The Player/official should also review the regulations of the world rugby.
- The Player/official should be prepared with any arguments he may wish to present, including for the purposes of sanctioning, with respect to off-field mitigating factors (on-field mitigating factors are considered in setting the entry point in regulations) and/or the absence of any aggravating factors.
- The official should bring with him a copy of his disciplinary record in all rugby (Fifteens and Sevens at all levels, including, for the avoidance of doubt, international, junior and Club) and other sports if relevant. If a copy is not available, the Player shall inform the Judicial Officer orally of his disciplinary record when requested. The Player should be careful not to make any inaccurate or misleading statements in this regard.
